

Valcambi at Salon International de la Haute Horlogerie, Geneva



Valcambi took the auditorium stage at the Salon International de la Haute Horlogerie ([SIHH](#)) on 17 January 2019 in Geneva.

Attended by over 23,000 visitors, including celebrities, industry experts and leading influencers, the salon gathered 35 fine watchmaking brands from the Richemont and Kering groups, among others, at the must-attend industry event.

As part of the '[Building Sustainable Gold Supply Chain](#)' panel discussion organised by the Foundation de la Haute Horlogerie ([FHH](#)), Virginie Bahon, Head of Corporate Affairs at Valcambi, shared the refiner's approach to responsible sourcing – based on extensive due diligence and traceability – and outlined the various options Valcambi offers to precious metals watchmaking buyers looking for responsible and fully traceable gold.

[Valcambi Green Gold](#), a fully traceable gold from Large Scale-Mining, and [Artisanal and Small-scale Mined Gold](#), were the centre of focus. Stating that the refiner also offers recycled gold, RJC CoC certified, Virginie invited fine watchmaking actors to join forces in making the gold sector more responsible overall.
