

### **Valcambi at the 11th OECD Forum on Responsible Mineral Supply Chains – May 2017**

Representatives from Valcambi joined the 11<sup>th</sup> OECD Forum on Responsible Mineral Supply Chains that took place on 2- 4 May 2017 in Paris.

Attended by more than 800 delegates, the Forum is the flagship event for countries, businesses and civil society organisations to advance implementation of the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas (OECD Guidance), the only international, government-backed standard for business to avoid contributing to conflict, serious human rights impacts, bribery, money-laundering and tax evasion through their mineral sourcing practices.

This edition of the Forum gave Valcambi the opportunity to pursue the constructive dialogue initiated with governments, NGOs and civil society organisations and share its latest development on Artisanal and Small-Scale Mining due diligence practices, getting constructive feedback from interested counterparties.
